PSALMS 122:6

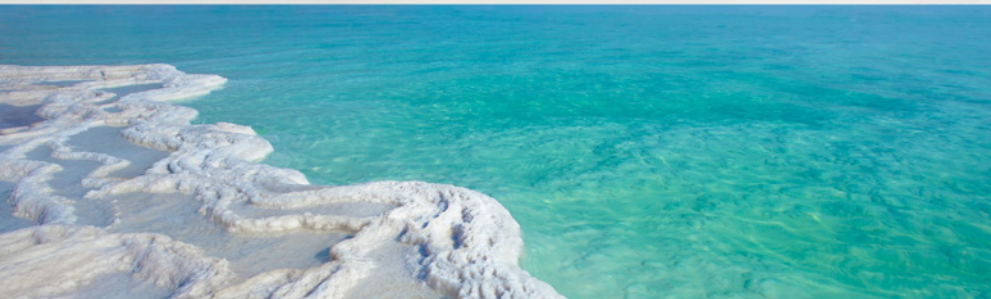
